

6th Transnational Meeting of EnterSchoolMind

Tuesday, 2 February 2021

On Tuesday, 2nd of February 2021, the 6th Transnational Meeting of the European project EnterSchoolMind took place online. EnterSchoolMind is a three-year project which aims to cultivate the entrepreneurial mindset in elementary schools through a holistic approach targeting teachers and pupils. Representatives of all the partners of the consortium, that is, MMC Ltd (Cyprus), Cyprus Certification Company (Cyprus), Dimitra Education and Consulting (Greece), Rinova Ltd (UK), FH Joanneum (Austria), 15Billion (UK), Apostolos Varnavas Primary School (Cyprus), 27 Primary School of Larissa (Greece) and GRUPPO4 (Italy) attended the meeting.

At the meeting, the overall progress of the project and the next steps to be taken were discussed, while new deadlines for the completion of future activities were set.



The meeting started with the confirmation of the completion of the certification process of the curricula and training materials for the pilot workshops for teachers. It was agreed that partners from Cyprus, Greece, UK and Austria can start implementing pilot workshops for at least three competences and that these should be completed by mid-March. MMC announced that online workshops for all 8 competences (beginning on the 3rd of February and ending on 26th of March) will be held in Cyprus. It was also agreed that the teachers' assessment will take place online on Moodle with a simultaneous invigilation of the Cyprus Certification Company.

The next topic discussed was the progress of the development of tools for the assessment of the pupils' entrepreneurial mindset. It was mentioned that the development of the creative stories has been completed, thus their electronic conversion may begin so as to be completed by the end of March. The design of the online application for the creative stories was decided upon by partners.

The meeting concluded with the discussion on the development and implementation of the activities (toolkit) to be used by teachers in schools for the development of the pupils' entrepreneurial mindset. It was agreed that the pilot testing of the toolkit should begin in April and be completed in June.

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
