On 20th of January consortium will meet in the online workshop for the review of the microcredentials developed and discuss results.

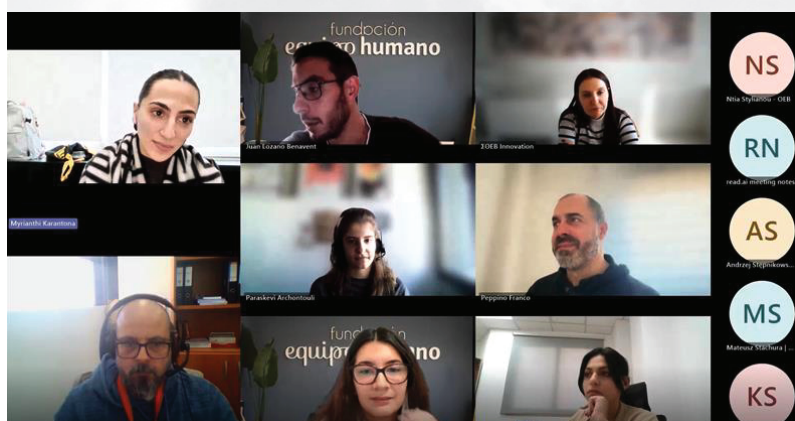
