

Current Phase

As summer 2025 wound to a close SUSEDI welcomed autumn with online Transformation Agent Training. Pulling from background material and Whole Institute Approach sustainability specifics, the online examination probed member knowledge for around 70-80 minut es touching on ideal WIA timelines, coaching-and-mentoring, and GreenComp principles, among others. The examinations sought to measure acumen and awareness among those designated to roll out practitioner training beyond the Consortium within members' respective institutions.

All told, 24 aspiring agents sat September examinations, and several others await similar accreditation before the end of October.



As the push escalates to recruit teaching staff, educators, and administrators from participating Educational Institutes for Sustainability Competence Leadership roles, SUSEDI Transformation Agents are collectively aiming to train around a hundred participants. Ultimately, SUSEDI's efforts to date should facilitate sustainable practice uptake and help embed systemic sustainability initiatives throughout Europe and farther afield.

Looking forward, SUSEDI participants not only begin their own upskilling ahead of the leadership training process but identify community engagement options as well, as they secure enthusiasts from inside and outside their schools, universities and training facilities. While few can doubt the merits of a Whole Institute Approach, finding a healthy spread of decision-makers and grassroots agents to implement and action sustainable practices poses another challenge altogether given busy schedules and additional workloads early in the academic year.

By Christmas 2025, the Consortium will know how many schools and institutions have opted into the WP3 pilot programme; the first cohort committed to SUSEDI's Whole Institute Approach initiative aimed at better-informing tomorrow's decision-makers for a sustainable future.
